## Flagship Events



#### Bringing Roma Voices to the European Capital of Culture Timisoara 2023 22 - 23 April | Timisoara

RDCC partnered up with the European Roma Institute for Arts and Culture (ERIAC) and joined "Timisoara 2023-European Capital of Culture" with an ambitious vision for the inclusion of Roma people and their culture in order to diversify and strengthen the program of the European Capital of Culture and to use Romani contributions to further leverage Timisoara's role as the European Capital of Culture. The program combined visual arts, music performances, and discursive events, presenting a program boosting true, unadulterated talent, and the true spirit of Roma music, featuring Gipsy Groove (Kosovo) and Mahala Rai Banda (Romania).

Each day, the event gathered more than 5000 participants in the main square of Timişoara.



#### ED&I in Eastern Europe Conference 2023 9 May 2023 | InterContinental Athenee Palace, Bucharest

The half-day event, organised in collaboration with the British-Romanian Chamber of Commerce, aimed at connecting senior diversity, equity and inclusion leaders from across the region to share best practices, insights and solutions for advancing ED&I in the workplace and beyond.

The Conference had 16 top speakers, 2 Ambassadors in the Opening and more than 120 guests in the audience.

#### Gender Equal Investment Funds Conference 2023 6 June 2023 | Marmorosch Hotel, Bucharest

RDCC organised the first event dedicated to investments and gender equality in Romania.

The conference brought up topics such as gender equality and investments in Central and Eastern Europe, challenges and opportunities for women in investment funds in Central and Eastern Europe, strategies for achieving gender diversity in investment funds, and will present several case studies of successful women-led investment funds in the region.

The event gathered 17 top speakers and 70 guests in the audience.



# Romanian Accessibility Awareness Day (RAAD) 19 September 2023 | Marmorosch Hotel, Bucharest

RAAD Conference 2023 aimed to provide a platform for dialogue and action, committed to promote inclusivity and accessibility within the Romanian business landscape.

In a significant stride towards fostering a broader international collaboration, this year's conference was coorganised with <u>AccessibleEU Centre</u>, an initiative by the European Commission that focuses on providing resources in key areas such as environment, transport, information, communication technologies, and policies.

By ensuring the equal participation of persons with disabilities across all aspects of life, this partnership added an European dimension to the conference's mission.

The event gathered 18 top speakers and the Israeli Ambassador, doing the Opening Remarks, with around 70 guests in the audience.

## Inclusive Recruitment Conference 3 October 2023 | Marmorosch Hotel, Bucharest

For the first time in Romania, the Romanian Diversity Chamber of Commerce organised the Inclusive Recruitment Conference, uniting professionals in diversity, inclusion, HR and talent. Attendees had the opportunity to take part in engaging panel discussions that revealed key topics such as building inclusive and transparent recruitment policies, bias reduction, accessible hiring processes, creating a culture of inclusion, and future trends in recruitment.

The event gathered 23 top speakers and almost 100 guests in the audience.



# Purple Night Romania 3 December 2023 | illumination campaign

At the 4rd edition of Purple Night campaign, a total number of 77 participants (68 private companies & NGOs, 3 embassies and 6 city halls) lit in purple 89 buildings and public spaces across the country; several participants took other actions to mark this celebration like wearing purple attire, purple bracelets, decorating the offices and shops in purple or even changing the company's logo to purple, to mark the International Day of Persons with Disabilities.

#PurpleNightRomania is a call to action developed by the Romanian Diversity Chamber of Commerce each year, on the day of December 3rd, in order to send a strong message of support and awareness for the inclusion of almost 1 million persons with disabilities living in Romania.

## **Activities and initiatives**

- ED&I Knowledge Center launch: officially, RDCC opened the doors of its ED&I Knowledge Center, announced made at the ED&I in Eastern Europe Conference in May 2023. RDCC has put together a team of 6 specialised ED&I trainers (3 from SNSPA University, 1 State Secretary from CNCD and 2 experts from the blind community), all conducted by Liliana Popescu, the Director of the Romanian Diplomatic Institute;
- 1st ED&I workshop delivered: for HPE, March 2023
- Task Force round tables: 2 rounds Task Forces on Disability, Ethnicity, Gender Equality and LGBTQ+ were organised in 2023. The first session was dedicated to finalising the indicators for the Certification Program, together with the RDCC members; the second set of meetings aimed at presenting the new ED&I Guide for SMEs that RDCC is developing together with its members, showcasing best practices for the following pillars: disability, gender equality, LGBT, age diversity and cultural diversity. The Guide is set to be launched in the 1st half 2024;
- Internal meetings for the preparation of the new Real Estate
   Task Force, with Skanska having the lead on the topic: the
   purpose of this new TF is to align all big players in the
   Romanian real estates landscape and discuss the challenges
   and opportunities for becoming more accessible for
   vulnerable population;
- Certification program: the ED&I Certification program has been officially launched, with Telios as the first pilot organisation to receive the Certification;
- Continues conversations among EIB, EBRD and commercial banks to improve bank finance to businesses owned or controlled by women and to organise the 2nd Gender equal Financing Conference 2024;

## **Activities and initiatives**

- Writing 2 projects for EU financing 2024 2026, together with IPP (Institute for Public Policies), REDI, Accept and Asociatia Municipillor din Romania; \*the final results have not been communicated until the development of the current report;
- Collaboration with the Clinique Juridique (developed by Bucharest Law School and Sorbonne Law School) and Dentons in providing legal support to minority entrepreneurs and SMEs;
- Collaboration with United Way: for the 18 Unrevoked project, where RDCC gathered several HR experts among its members to informally discuss with 30 young adults that are coming out from the social system about the importance of having a job, how to present to an interview and how to write a CV;
- Organisation of "Advancing LGBT+ Rights in Romania and the Role of Multi-Nationals" roundtable, in collaboration with Stonewall UK, on 25th Sept at Dentons, Bucharest. The main purpose of the meeting was to discuss the current challenges that the LGBT+ community is facing in Romania. aprox. 20 guests in person and 10 online;
- Participation in the inter-embassy working group for LGBT+ issues (second meeting hosted by the Spanish Embassy);
- Continuous development of the ED&I Online Library with the support of our members and partners, who sent us relevant reports, studies and policies in ED&I that they've developed;
- ED&I interview series new members have received a series
  of questions about their company, their work and involvement
  in ED&I related topics; the interviews will be featured on RDCC
  website & social media pages;

## **Activities and initiatives**

- Development of the Inklusive App in collaboration with Accenture Romania, dedicated to the LGBT community on where to find lifestyle, medical, legal information and friendly service providers;
- Active awareness and communication on different topics of interest in the field of ED&I, on social media, in the national press and via RDCC's newsletter channel;
- New members recruited: Skanska, DB Cargo, Philip Morris International, Molson Coors, Public Affairs Solutions, NESsT, Accessible Ro by Sano Touring and Martyn Birchall as an entrepreneur;
- New MoUs signed: with BRCC (British-Romanian Chamber of Commerce) and CBEX (the Canadian Business Exchange Association);
- New partnerships: with ERIAC, AccessibleEU and WeMaster.
