

ED&I in Eastern Europe Conference 2024

The ED&I in Eastern Europe Conference which was at its 3rd edition in 2024 had an impressive lineup of 20 speakers from Romania and abroad, 2 Ambassadors in the Opening and more than 150 guests in the audience. It is the second biggest flagship event run by the RDCC. The half-day event aimed at connecting senior diversity, equity and inclusion leader from across the region to share best practices, insights and solutions for advancing ED&I in the workplace and beyond.



Gender Equal Financing Conference 2024

11 June 2024 | Marmorosch Hotel, Bucharest

RDCC organised the 2nd edition of this event dedicated to investments and gender equality in Romania. The conference gathered 12 top speakers and 100 people in the audience around the topic of reversing gender inequality gains. This year, the event also featured a working group powered by EBRD, BCR, ING & Raiffeisen where female entrepreneurs brainstormed about the challenges and opportunities for women in investment funds in Central and Eastern Europe, as well as strategies for achieving gender diversity in investment funds. The working group is part of a larger initiative of the RDCC that aims to conduct a report at a national level about the level of access that women entrepreneurs have in terms of obtaining financing.

LGBTQ+ @ Work Conference 2024

This year's 3rd edition of the LGBTQ+ @ Work Conference marked the launch of the InKlusive App. The application is a joint initiative developed by Accenture together with the Romanian Diversity Chamber of Commerce (RDCC). InKlusive offers a nationwide platform featuring a database of healthcare and legal professionals, alongside job listings from ED&I leader employers that aim to combat the problem of LGBTQ+ discrimination. At the same time, we teamed up with organisations such as Open For Business, NESsT Violet Fund, UNHCR and Stonewall to discuss strategies on how to attract new talents from the community and enhance inclusivity.

Jim Hodges, President & Ceo of McGuireWoods Consulting and former Governor of South Carolina together with Codrin Scutaru, CEO Public Affairs Solutions provided a nuanced analysis of the elections' impact on both sides of the Atlantic.

- Breakfast Talks & Task Force round tables The launch of a new Task Force event on Real Estate, as well as 3 breakfast talks on Refugees, Political and Economic perspectives and Artificial Intelligence were organised in 2024;
- Certification program with the ED&I Certification program's
 official launch in 2023, Telios was the first pilot organisation to
 receive the Certification and is now a Bronze member. The RDCC
 is currently working on offering the certification service as a
 product on the market;
- Bank Forum The continuos conversations among EIB, EBRD and commercial banks led to the hosting of the first women oriented bank forum part of 2nd Gender equal Financing Conference 2024.
 The goal was to try and identify what specific bank products women entrepreneurs need in Romania and to implement other best practices from offices worldwide;

- Collaboration with the Clinique Juridique (developed by Bucharest Law School and Sorbonne Law School) and Dentons in providing legal support to minority entrepreneurs and SMEs; Starting with 2024, in a collaborative effort with UNHCR, the Romanian Diversity Chamber of Commerce is offering free legal advice for refugees to ensure that they can effectively exercise their rights in Romania
- ED&I Knowledge Center: RDCC has put together a team of 6
 specialised ED&I trainers (3 from SNSPA University, 1 State Secretary
 from CNCD and 2 experts from the blind community), all conducted by
 Liliana Popescu, the Director of the Romanian Diplomatic Institute
- ED&I interview series new members have received a series of questions about their company, their work and involvement in ED&I related topics; the interviews will be featured on RDCC website & social media pages;
- New Diversity Chamber of Commerce branches together with trusted partners of the Romanian Diversity Chamber of Commerce from Warsaw and Rome, discussions to open two new sister chambers in Poland and Italy began in 2024
- Purple Night Romania 2024 now organised at its fifth edition, the Romanian Diversity Chamber of Commerce gathered 110 buildings nationally in making a visible statement of support for the community of people with disabilities. For the first time since its creation, Purple Night Romania 2024 also had a building outside of Romania part of this initiative in Hungary
